

## G. Shifting Ships along Northport Berths



### SHIFTING SHIPS ALONG NORTHPORT BERTHS

- The shifting of ships along Northport berths may only be carried out with permission from Northport who reserves the right to refuse any shift

- Ship's agent only can make the order for a shift ship

#### Non-assisted Shift Ship

- Maximum distance to be no more than 20m
- To be carried out at slack water only
- Wind strength to be no more than 10 knots
- Pilot and 4 person lines party
- 2 of the linesmen must be capable of operating a workboat
- Whangarei Harbour Radio to be notified before and after the shift is carried out

#### Assisted Shift Ship

- Shifts greater than 20m
- Wind strength during shift greater than 10 knots
- Normal berthing criteria to be used which include Pilot, Tugs and 4 Linesmen
