- 5. To ensure that Northport Ltd. provides a robust Fatigue Management System that meets industry best practice.
- 6. To continue to promote the use of internal and external audit processes, to identify further improvements to Northport Ltd.'s Health and Safety system.

7. To support MNZ's Health and Safety at Work Act (HSWA) designation extension to the port gate.
